Dear Mr. Gallego:

We have received your request for renewal of our reciprocal recognition of your state of California radioactive materials license number 2105-30 under WAC 246-232-040. This letter hereby grants your request for the period April 30, 2008, through April 30, 2009. You may conduct work under this reciprocity agreement for up to 180 days during the twelve month period. We ask that you notify this office at least three days prior to each different time your company enters this state to perform work under reciprocity. The State of Washington requires the following records to be available at the temporary job site:

1. A copy of your radioactive materials license.
2. A copy of current operating and emergency procedures, and shipping papers.
3. A copy of your own state's regulations, N.R.C. regulations, or Washington regulations.
4. The latest leak test records for sealed sources containing radioactive material present at the job site.
5. Training certificates for anyone not listed on the license.
6. Copies of the latest dosimetry reports for individuals who will be using the radioactive material.
7. The latest survey meter calibration records for devices in use at the job site.
